









GRADUATING WITH CLASS

The academic impact of missing school is the same whether the absences are excused or unexcused. Too many absences can keep students from succeeding in life and in school. How many are too many?

Attendance Trend	Impact on Graduation	Chronic Absences	Impact on Academics	Impact of Improvement
<p>50% of students who miss 2-4 days in September will go on to miss nearly a month of school.</p> 	<p>20% chance of graduating if a student misses 20 days of school per year.</p> 	<p>1 in 10 Kindergartners and first graders are chronically absent.</p> 	<p>10% missing this amount of the school year, or about 18 days, negatively affects a student's academic performance.</p> 	<p>100% improvement of students' academic prospects and chances for graduating when they improve their daily attendance rates.</p>
